## NEW PUC/CEC SOLAR WEBSITE UNVEILED BY GOVERNOR; ONE-STOP SOLAR INFORMATION CENTER FOR CONSUMERS

SAN FRANCISCO, October 19, 2006 -- Today at the Solar Power 2006

Conference and Expo in San Jose Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger unveiled a new state website from the California Public Utilities Commission (PUC) and the California Energy Commission, <a href="www.GoSolarCalifornia.ca.gov">www.GoSolarCalifornia.ca.gov</a>, reinforcing the state's dedication to solar power.

As part of Governor Schwarzenegger's Million Solar Roofs program, California has set a goal to create 3,000 megawatts of new, solar-produced electricity by 2017 - moving the state toward a cleaner energy future and helping lower the cost of solar systems for consumers.
